



7783-20-2, Ammonium Sulfate

This inorganic sulfate salt presents as a white and odorless fine crystalline powder. It is known to be soluble in water and insoluble in ethanol and acetone. For best results, store this hygroscopic substance at 15°C to 30°C. Ammonium Sulfate is found in nature as the mineral mascagnite, and is incompatible with strong bases. Contact with strong oxidizers may cause fire or explosion. Acute oral toxicity is indicated and this chemical may be harmful if swallowed. It is also harmful to aquatic life with long lasting effects, so avoid release to the environment.

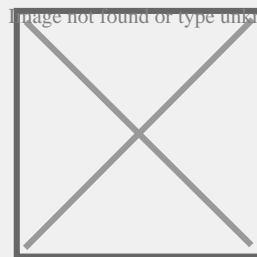
